

West London Junior Netball League Rules

6. BEE NETBALL ROTATION SHEETS

6.1 Bee Netball is played under the England netball “Stingers” rule book. You can download a copy of the rule book here: <https://hive.Englandnetball.co.uk/the-hive/>

6.2 All players must be listed on the team registration sheet and must be an active EN membership. Each team entered must have an allocated registration form. If a team plays a player’s not registered with the squad this will be an automatic friendly and must be declared at the beginning of the fixture. i.e Each player can only be registered for one squad during a season.

6.3 Bee netball players should rotate after each quarter of each game using the EN rotation sheets. template. (Template supplied)

6.4 Each Match starts on Rotation 1 and ends on rotation 4. If a player is not on the Bee netball rotation sheet before the start of play, or a player who is on the rotation sheet does not arrive before the start of the 2nd quarter, they are unable to play for the duration of that match.

6.5 Team Rotation sheets to be exchanged by BEE team manager and the start of the match. Failure to present the sheet before the first whistle will result in the match being a friendly, and should be filled in the league folder at the end of the match.

6.6 Each team must have a minimum of 7 players and a maximum of 9 players.

6.7 LATE PLAYERS- if player(s) are running late, they must be written on the rotation sheet that is exchanged at the start of the game. Late players must be ready to take the court at the start of the second quarter playing in the dedicated positions as assigned by the England Netball rotation sheet. I.e ROTATION 7 player 1 is designated **OFF** in the first quarter.

Rotation sheets must be exchanged 5 minutes at will result in an automatic win for the opposition (6-0) for the nonoffending team and the offending team will be deducted 1 point. The game can still be played as a friendly fixture.

6.7 If a team chooses to play an unregistered player or a player who arrived after the start of the 2nd quarter, the game will be deemed a friendly and the points awarded to the opposing team in line with the fulfilling fixtures rules.

6.8 Where a team has made changes to their original rotation sheet, that was submitted before the start of the fixture, due to injury or player absence, the team is required to inform the hosting table and complete an updated rotation sheet.

6.9 The Committee, reserves the right to check teams’ rotations at any time.



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Team rotation sheets to be exchanged to the coach you are playing no later than 5 minutes before the start of the match. (9.55 am).

Squad rotations 7, 8 or 9, no substitutes allowed. If a player is injured and not able to return to the court and have a rotation 7 and drops to a 6 automatic friendly. If have a 8 or 9 rotations can submit a new 7 or 8 rotations before the start of the next quarter.
